

GMVEMSC JITSO for Nasotracheal Intubation

As of April 15, 2026, The Ohio EMFTS amended the scope of practice for all levels in the state of Ohio, actively removing the skill of nasotracheal intubation. This skill is currently listed under General Protocol 1008 and 1009 of the GMVEMSC Standing Orders. These protocols will be updated to match the state scope of practice.

In place of nasotracheal intubation, sedate to intubate and rapid sequence intubation still exist under General Protocol 1008 and 1010.

Core Competency

Nasotracheal intubation, which was previously permitted for the **Paramedic** level of certification, **has been removed from the Ohio EMS scope of practice** and is no longer permitted to be performed.
